# HOUSING

## Displacement & Eviction

When a tenant or mobile homeowner is facing displacement and eviction, it is recommended to take the following steps:

1. Contact the Housing Mediation Project, where free, trained third-party mediators will determine whether the situation is appropriate for mediation. During mediation, mediators help both parties find a mutually acceptable resolution and create a written agreement signed by both parties. Mediators may refer parties to community resources as well.
2. Show up to the mediation! An agreement can't be made if the tenant and landlord aren't present.
3. If the eviction is due to money issues, such as not paying rent or a rent increase, contact Blaine County Charitable Fund and/or South Central Community Action Partnership.
4. Mediators may refer parties to Idaho Legal Aid or the Intermountain Fair Housing Council if the parties have legal questions of concerns.
5. If a court date is set, show up! If the tenant doesn't show up, they will likely receive a default eviction judgement. On the other hand, filing an eviction does not always result in eviction – meaning the tenant might be able to stay in their home if they participate in mediation.

### *Housing Mediation Project*

The Housing Mediation Project is a free mediation program that provides landlords and tenants with an avenue for resolving housing-related issues without filing an eviction with the court. Tenants can avoid an eviction filing on their permanent public record (which can make it extremely difficult to access new housing), maintain stable housing, and reduce disruption if a move is unavoidable. Landlords can receive late and no rent payments, save time, remedy property issues, and avoid legal and court fees associated with filing an eviction.
